

SOMERSET COUNTY RECREATIONAL GRANT PROGRAM ACKNOWLEDGEMENT SIGN GUIDELINES

The Recreation Grant Program was implemented to provide funding assistance to municipalities for the development of active and passive recreational facilities. Guidelines for the Program, adopted by the Somerset County Board of County Commissioners on January 12, 2021 and amended on December 13, 2021 outline the requirements for the request for funding through the Program.

- In exchange for Recreation Grant funding the municipality will erect a permanent sign at the Project location acknowledging the County’s contribution toward the Project. The sign shall include the following language:

Project Name

“This project was developed with assistance provided by the Somerset County Board of County Commissioners through the County Open Space Preservation Trust Fund Recreation Grant Program.”

- The sign may be a freestanding sign or be incorporated into other Project signage. If the sign is to be freestanding, the minimum size shall be 18”x24”.
- The sign shall be located in an area of the Project that can be clearly seen by the general public.
- The final design, size and location of the sign shall be mutually agreed upon by the County and municipality.
