



SOMERSET COUNTY TRAILS GRANT PROGRAM ACKNOWLEDGEMENT SIGN GUIDELINES



The Somerset County Trails Grant Program was established by the Somerset County Board of County Commissioners and adopted on April 22, 2025, to support its municipalities through its Open Space, Farmland, and Historic Preservation Trust Fund in creating a network of trails on publicly preserved land that will benefit the communities and enhance the quality of life of county residents.

- In exchange for Trails Grant funding the municipality will erect a permanent sign at the Project location acknowledging the County’s contribution toward the Project. The sign shall include the following language:

Project Name

“This project was developed with assistance provided by the Somerset County Board of County Commissioners through the County Open Space Preservation Trust Fund Trails Grant Program.”

- The sign may be a freestanding sign, or the language may be incorporated into other Project signage. If the sign is to be freestanding, the minimum size shall be 18”x24”.
- The sign shall be located in an area of the Project that can be clearly seen by the general public.
- The final design, size and location of the sign shall be mutually agreed upon by the County and municipality.
